Built in 1902, Cultra Manor was the last country house raised by the landed gentry in Ireland.

It continues to embody the best of that golden age, thanks to meticulous conservation and restoration under the direction of the National Museums NI Curatorial Team. Inside, you'll discover spacious rooms, furnished with period pieces and décor, brought up-to-date with cutting edge audio visual and IT equipment.

The mansion stands on a ridge above the Ulster Folk Museum in Holywood and enjoys sweeping views of Belfast Lough, expansive lawns, woodland and gardens. It offers a world away from the noise and confusion of everyday life – a country retreat on the fringe of the city available for your exclusive use.

The Kennedy family were local squires, gentry farmers and keen sportspeople who had lived at Cultra since the 17th century. Sir Robert Kennedy, an accomplished diplomat, built Cultra Manor at the turn of the 20th century to crown his achievements in London and abroad.

Kennedy Room



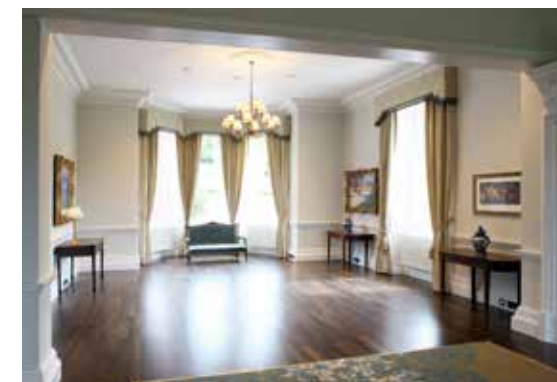
The Kennedy Room is our signature space. It offers a large yet friendly space, adorned with period furniture & fittings as well as a modern AV system including an integrated projector and screen.

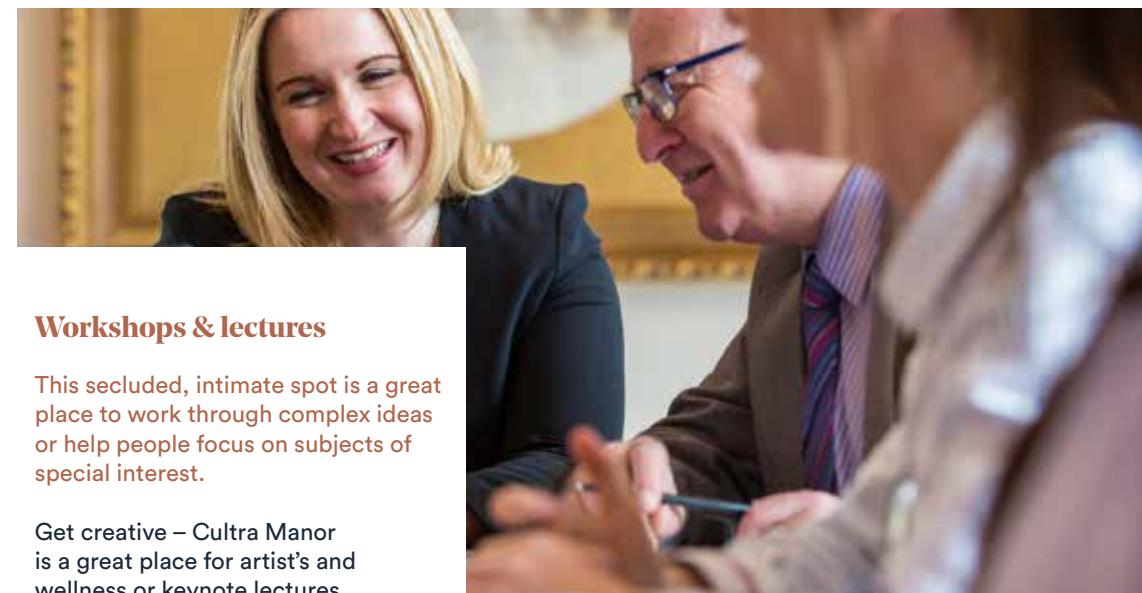

History and Heritage

The Kennedy family have been resident in Cultra since the late 17th century, when they moved from Ayrshire. Their initial residence was a Tudor revival home known as Cultra House.

The family was renowned as local gentry farmers and keen sports people. They were among the first to patronise the local yacht club.

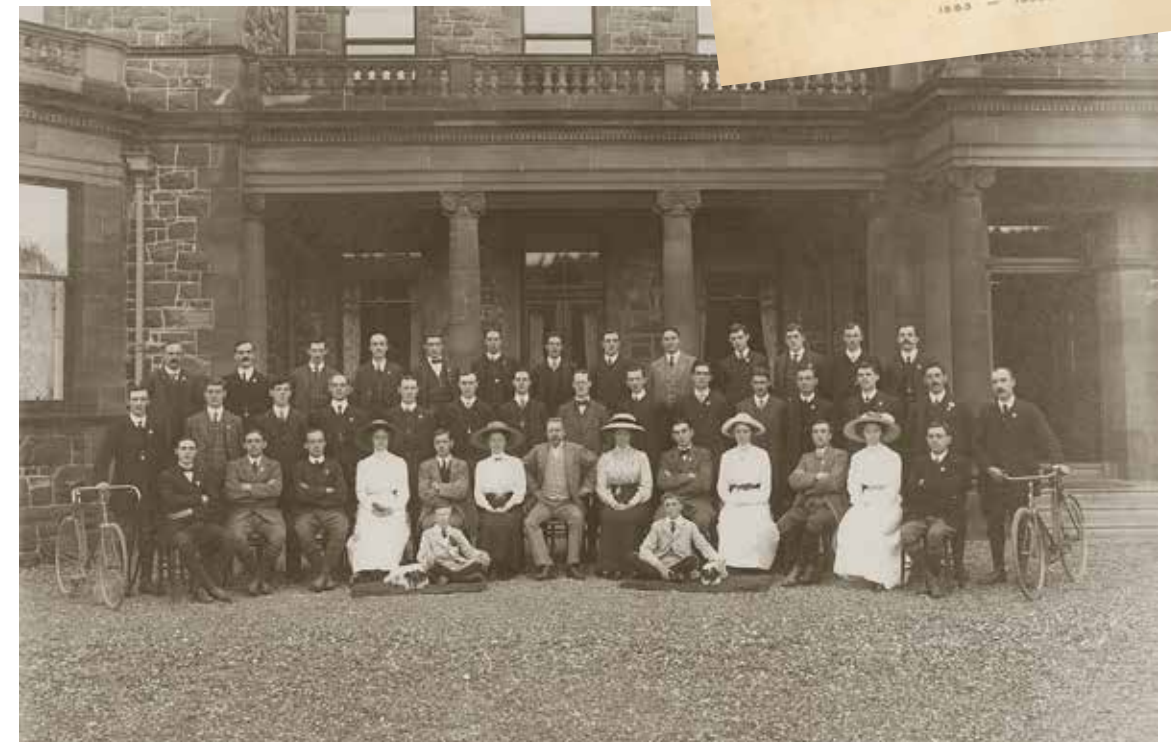
Sir Robert Kennedy inherited the Cultra estate 1872, at the beginning of an illustrious career. He graduated from Oxford two years later and went on to a distinguished diplomatic career. His duties saw him posted to the Ottoman Empire, South America and Central Asia. His wife, Bertha, became “the first European woman to enter Afghanistan”.

The Kennedys built Cultra Manor to celebrate their life's work and as a comfortable retreat for their retirement. It was built in local greywacke and Scottish sandstone to designs by James Hunter, the architect behind the Scottish Provident Buildings on Donegall Square. Construction was completed in 1902 and the Kennedys moved here permanently in 1912. They passed away within months of each other in 1936.

National Museums NI acquired Cultra Manor in 1961 and it has been our privilege to maintain and restore this exquisite estate ever since.
